ABOUT THE CIRRICULUM:

The Doyle Sailmaking Programme is a comprehensive, hands on training programme that is based at our Doyle Sails New Zealand facility. Successful applicants will take part in a wide variety of workshops, skill development sessions and reviews that will ensure that at the time of certification they are a competent sailmaker that is internationally recognised within the Doyle Sails group.

The Doyle Sailmaking Programme takes three years to complete and covers all areas of sailmaking with minor standards in other complimentary areas such as service and rigging plus incorporates first aid and other valuable skills to ensure that our sailmakers meet the high standard of workmanship Doyle Sails requires globally. Each sailmaker will work through their tailored sailmaking programme workbook alongside their team leaders and supervisors to complete a series of assessments.

Each year, we also include a range of extra curricular activities for our applicants to take part in - for example, first aid qualifications, high ropes courses, team building and social events.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

If you would like to join our team of world class sailmakers, it is important to complete the application form in this information guide and email it to emma.hendy@doylesails.com. Once your application has been received and the information meets our criteria, we will be in contact to arrange an interview. We like to meet with you on site at Doyle Sails as we can then show you the working environment in a little more detail. Sometimes, more than one interview is required and once our facilitator has met with you and discussed all that is required, a formal approval or declination will be made.

INTERNATIONAL APPLICATIONS:

If you are looking to apply for a Doyle Sailmaking position and you don't live in New Zealand, you will need to check what type of visa you will require to live and work in the country. Different countries of origin have differing visa requirements, so it is best to check with Immigration New Zealand that you have the correct documentation before you make the big move.

If you would like to make an international application, we will happily conduct interviews online. Please complete your application form in this information pack.

EMPLOYMENT:

All of our Doyle Sailmaking Programme positions are paid. If your application is successful your position within Doyle Sails will be formalised with a personalised employment contract like the rest of our staff. Once your contract is signed by both parties you will be required to follow the same regulations and processes as all Doyle Sails employees with regards to code of conduct, health and safety regulations, leave applications etc.

LEAVE APPLICATIONS:

A number of our current sailmakers completing this programme work with Doyle Sails while also pursuing a career in yacht racing. Leave applications for events and regattas will be considered on a case by case basis and as per the leave requirements of your contract. It is important to speak with the Doyle Sailmaking Programme facilitator during your interview about your external requirements so that everyone is on the same page.

VISITING A LOFT:

If you are interested in becoming a Doyle Sailmaker, but want to know more, we would love for you to visit us at our loft. Our Doyle Sailmaking Programme facilitator would be happy to walk you through the loft and give you a little bit more in depth information about what it is like to be a sailmaker.

INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL OPPORTUNITIES:

Doyle Sails operates with over 50 lofts worldwide with 6 operating as central hubs within the Doyle Sailmaking Programme. Each year sailmakers that are in their third year of the programme, will have the opportunity to apply for a paid placement in one of our six primary lofts where you will gain valuable work experience overseas and travel to some of the most amazing countries in the world. Each successful applicant will receive return flights and their normal employment package while they are overseas. - as all requirements around accommodation differ for each placement, this will be discussed with the successful applicant prior to travel. All visa requirements and travel administration will be handled by Doyle Sails New Zealand. The successful applicant will be required to ensure they are legally able to travel to the destination country and that they have a valid passport.
